

## CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP 2019

<b>ORDINARY:</b>	A person between 18 and State Retirement Age.
<b>SENIOR CITIZEN:</b>	A person of State Retirement Age.
<b>DISABLED:</b>	A person in receipt of a disability benefit. Send a copy of the CURRENT letter from the Benefits Agency. Blue parking badges are <b>NOT</b> accepted as evidence.
<b>INTERMEDIATE:</b>	A person aged 15, 16 or 17 on 1st April 2019.
<b>ADDITIONS TO THE ABOVE:</b>	( Must fish in the same swim as senior member above with ONE rod only)
<b>JUNIOR:</b>	Between the ages of five and their 15th birthday.
<b>ASSOCIATE:</b>	Spouse or partner <b>ONLY</b> of a full member above who wishes to enter Club waters and fish occasionally.
<b>NON-FISHING:</b>	A person wishing to enter Club waters, but with no right to fish. ( <b>Separate form and photo required</b> )
<b>DATE OF BIRTH:</b>	Required for all members. Omission <b>WILL</b> delay your application.

<b>CLOSE SEASON:</b> (Stillwaters)	April only, to allow us to work on our waters (fishing available to work party attendees during April).
<b>GATES:</b>	All gates have key operated padlocks, a key will be provided free to new members.
<b>WEBSITE:</b> <a href="http://www.bdac.co.uk">www.bdac.co.uk</a>	This is used to give information to prospective members, and also to existing members with recent catch reports, plus photos, and any important news about our waters, match results, lost and found, etc.

<b>NEWSLETTER:</b>	A high-quality colour edition issued in late February.
<b>MATCHES:</b>	Match Championship. Retired and Disabled. Ladies. Juniors. Mixed Pairs. Charity Carp and Pike matches.

**CLUB WATERS** (KEY) **T** Toilets on site **N** Night fishing allowed (additional fee for Crays Hill &/or Laundry Lake, see below)  
**K** Keepnets allowed (may be withdrawn during hot weather, etc.) **B** Barbless hooks only.

<b>SOUTHMINSTER: T K N B</b>	A freehold complex of nine lakes. Carp to 20lbs, tench to 6lbs, bream to 8lbs, roach, rudd, perch, gudgeon.
<b>BRAINTREE: T K B</b>	A freehold site with two lakes. Carp to 28lbs, tench to 8lbs, bream to 8lbs, pike to 24lbs, perch, roach, rudd, eels.
<b>ASHELDHAM: T K N B</b>	A freehold lake with numerous bays. Carp to 23lbs, eels to 8lbs, roach, rudd, perch, tench.
<b>MOUNTNESSING: T B</b>	Four lakes over two locations. Carp to 28lbs, tench to 7lbs, bream to 8lbs, roach, rudd, perch.
<b>INGATESTONE: T B</b>	Three lakes over two locations. Carp to 30lbs, tench to 7lbs, bream to 9lbs, roach, rudd, perch.
<b>CRAYS HILL: T K B N*</b>	Agricultural reservoir. Carp to 38lbs, eels to 9lbs, roach, tench, bream. (72-hour limit) * From 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2019 an additional fee is payable for night fishing (9 p.m. - 6 a.m.). See over.
<b>BICKNACRE: T K N B</b>	6-acre lake. Carp to 30lbs, bream to 8lbs, perch to 3lbs, rudd, roach.
<b>LITTLE EASTON, Laundry: T B N*</b>	A three acre lake containing carp to over 35lbs. (72-hour limit) * From 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2019 an additional fee is payable for night fishing (9 p.m. - 6 a.m.). See over.
<b>LITTLE EASTON, Rectory: T B</b>	Two connected ponds containing carp to 20lbs, roach to 2lbs, bream and crucians.
<b>HIGH EASTER: T K B</b>	Agricultural reservoir. Tench to 6lbs, roach, bream, perch, rudd, and crucians.
<b>WRITTLE: T K B</b>	1.5-acre lake. Carp to 25lbs, pike to 18lbs, bream, tench, brown goldfish, roach, perch, rudd.
<b>WEST HANNINGFIELD: T B</b>	1.5 acre lake. Carp to 23lbs, roach, gudgeon.
<b>SHALFORD: T B</b>	Two small ponds, & two agricultural reservoirs nearby. Carp to 15lbs, tench, roach, rudd, chub.
<b>RIVER PANT, SHALFORD: K</b>	1 mile with 3 access points. Chub to 4lbs, roach, dace, brown trout, carp, perch, bream.
<b>RIVER BLACKWATER, BRAINTREE: T K</b>	Skirting our lakes (above). Chub to 4lbs, roach, dace, perch, carp, pike.
<b>RIVER RODING, STANFORD RIVERS: K</b>	2 miles with 3 access points. Chub to 6lbs, roach to 2lbs, dace, perch, pike.
<b>RIVER RODING, ABRIDGE: K N</b>	Third-mile of bank. Chub to 6lbs, roach to 2lbs, tench, perch, dace, eels, pike.
<b>RIVER WID, WRITTLE: K</b>	A mile stretch with a weirpool. Chub to 5lbs, roach to 2lbs, bream to 4lbs, pike, dace, carp, tench, eels.
<b>RIVER STOUR, HENNY STREET: K N</b>	¾ -mile with a weirpool. Chub to 6lbs, pike to 22lbs, bream to 10lbs, roach, perch, tench.
